MEASURES ADOPTED IN BOLIVIA DUE COVID-19

On March 17, 2020 the Bolivian government announced the following measures, effective through March 31, 2020:

- Beginning at 00:00h on March 20, entry to Bolivia will be restricted to only Bolivian Citizens. Bolivian citizens will be subject to health protocols.
- Beginning at 00:00h on March 21, all international flights are suspended.
- Beginning at 00:00h on March 21, all national passenger flights are suspended.
- Beginning at 00:00h on March 21, all international, interdepartmental, and interprovincial travel by land, river, or lake is suspended.
- Effective immediately, commercial establishments will be open 8:00-15:00 for opening and attention to the public.
- Effective immediately, the workday is 8:00-13:00.
- Effective immediately, there is a general curfew from 17:00-6:00.
- Effective immediately, public transport is limited to 6:00-18:00.

As of March 16, 2020, discotheques, bars, movie theaters, sporting events, large gatherings, gyms, amusement parks, night-time activities at event halls, and any gathering of over 100 persons are prohibited.

Entry and Exit Requirements:

- Beginning at 00:00h on March 20, entry to Bolivia is restricted to only Bolivian citizens. Bolivian citizens will be subject to health protocols established by the World Health Organization.
- Beginning Wednesday, March 18, 2020, foreign travelers coming from the Schengen Zone, the United Kingdom, Ireland, or Iran will not be admitted to Bolivia.
